THE SHEEP DEVELOPMENT PLAN REGULATIONS, 2013 -PRODUCER REGISTRATION

Order No. 29/15. The SHEEP DEVELOPMENT BOARD, pursuant to the provisions of The Sheep Development Plan Regulations, 2013 and The Agri-Food Act, 2004 hereby determines and orders as follows:

- 1 Each producer shall register on a registration form provided by the board within 45 days of being requested to do so.
- 2 All registered producers shall renew their registration with the board before January 15 of each year on a registration form provided by the board.
- **3** Each producer shall supply the following information on a registration form provided by the board:
 - (a) the name under which the producer carries on his or her business along with his or her mailing address and telephone number.
 - (b) in the case of a corporation, association, society or other designation, the names of all of the individuals involved in the production unit, their mailing addresses and their telephone numbers.
 - (c) legal land description of the main production unit; and Saskatchewan Premise Identification Number (PID Number) of the main production unit; and
 - (d) the number of registered and commercial ewes and their breed.
- 4 The information collected on the registration form is for the internal use of the board and kept confidential, except when required by law to provide relevant information.

Annual Producer Registration with the Saskatchewan Sheep Development Board (SSDB)

SSDB would like the producers of Saskatchewan to have the following information:

- 1. The Sheep Development Plan Regulations 2013 Producer Registration Order No. 29/15. as pertaining to producer registration requirements.
- 2. There is no cost to registering with the SSDB.
- 3. Why do we need this information?
 - The number of sheep and producers are used for lobbying and developing the sheep industry.
 - Location of production unit determines producer region for voting purposes.
 - Email addresses are used for Ewe Line Services, misc. communication, and Sheep Shape.
 - Mailing address is used for our various paper communications i.e.) research participation.
- 4. What is done with this information?
 - All information is kept confidential and is used internally, except when required by law to provide information i.e.) disease outbreak, surveillance and natural disaster.
 - Permission must be obtained from the producer when used for any other purpose.
- 5. What are the advantages of registering?
 - Comply with the regulations.
 - To stay connected with the SSDB.
 - Registered producers receive industry informational mailings.
 - Registered producers have access to free advertising on the www.sksheep.com website.
 - Registered producers, through Ewe Line, have the opportunity to access Ewe Shoppe specials, market opportunities and timely information.
 - Registered producers have the opportunity to vote and to contribute to the organization.
